## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY OF HAGERSTOWN BY DELETING AND REPEALING CHAPTER 209 THEREOF, SEDIMENT CONTROL, AND REPLACING THE REPEALED CHAPTER WITH A NEW CHAPTER 209, ENTITLED SEDIMENT CONTROL

## **RECITALS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hagerstown has previously adopted a Sediment Control Ordinance at Chapter 209 of the Code of the City of Hagerstown; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of the Environment and the Soil Conservation Districts have modified the regulations governing Erosion and Sediment Control requirements within the State; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to revise and update Chapter 209 to comply with State law; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find it in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Hagerstown to do so;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hagerstown, Maryland, as its duly constituted legislative body, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Code of the City of Hagerstown, Chapter 209, Sediment Control is hereby amended by deleting and repealing Chapter 209, and by adopting a new Chapter 209 to replace the said Chapter 209 hereinabove repealed, to read as follows:
